

RESOLUTION NO. 412

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING
AN INTERIM OPEN SPACE AND CONSERVATION
ELEMENT OF THE GENERAL PLAN

WHEREAS, The City of Ridgecrest Planning Commission, in its Resolution No. 72-79, recommend adoption of the Interim Open Space and Conservation Element of the County of Kern General Plan as the Interim Open Space and Conservation Element of the City of Ridgecrest General Plan, and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Government Code Section 65300 et seq., the City Council gave required notice and held a public hearing on the 17th day of August, 1972, for the purpose of considering adoption of the Interim Open Space and Conservation Element of the General Plan reports and maps, at which public hearing the Interim Element was explained, and

WHEREAS, The adoption of an interim open space plan before August 31, 1972, is required of cities and counties by Chapter 251, Statutes of 1972 Regular Legislative Session which amended Section 65563 of the Government Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

1. The City Council does hereby approve and adopt as a supplement to its General Plan on an interim basis that portion of the County of Kern's Open Space and Conservation Element which applies to the city and the immediately adjacent areas.

2. The City Clerk is instructed to transmit to the Secretary of the Resources Agency of the State of California a letter advising of the City of Ridgecrest's compliance with Chapter 251 of the Statutes of the 1972 Regular Legislative Session.




