

RESOLUTION NO. 436

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING A  
PORTION OF WEST RIDGECREST BOULEVARD AS  
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 2 of Ordinance No. 88, the City Council held a public hearing on the formation of an underground utility district along West Ridgcrest Boulevard from China Lake Boulevard to South Norma Street; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 3 of said Ordinance, the City Engineer submitted a report describing costs to the City, utilities, and affected property owners along said Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, No objections to the formation of said proposed underground utility district were received in writing or orally before or at the public hearing held November 16, 1972;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

1. The public necessity requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures within the area designated below and requires the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service within the below designated area:

2. The following designated area is hereby declared to be Underground Utility District No. One (1):

From five feet north of to five feet south of the right of way of West Ridgcrest Boulevard from the west line of China Lake Boulevard to the centerline of South Norma Street.

3. It is hereby ordered that poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures within the above designated area be removed and that, except for ornamental street light electroliers, all electrical and communication distribution facilities in the above designated area be placed underground including wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service and including wiring for said electroliers.

4. Such removal and underground installation shall be accomplished in two phases by the dates specified below and such property owners within said designated area as are to receive service from said underground facilities shall be prepared to receive said service by the following dates:

Phase One - From the west side of China Lake Boulevard to one hundred and fifty feet (150') east of the east line of North Alvord Street - July 1, 1974.

Phase Two - From one hundred and fifty feet (150') east of the east line of North Alvord Street to the centerline of South Norma Street - July 1, 1978.

5. Such removal and underground installation shall be accomplished at the cost of the Southern California Edison Company using budgeted Rule 20 undergrounding funds and such advanced Rule 20 funds as are found necessary to use, except that property owners within said designated area as are to receive service from said underground facilities shall provide facilities on their respective properties to receive such service at their own cost.
