

RESOLUTION NO. 438

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING GRANT DEED FOR A PORTION OF SOUTH CHINA LAKE BOULEVARD RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, Edith Bubar, as property owner, has offered for dedication a portion of South China Lake Boulevard for right-of-way purposes, legally described as:

A parcel of land located in the NE/4 of Section 4, T. 27 S., R. 40 E., MDB&M, in the City of Ridgecrest, more particularly described as follows:

The east 20 feet of the following described parcel:

Beginning 220 feet south and 30 feet west of the northeast corner of said Section 4, thence (1) west a distance of 270 feet, thence (2) south a distance of 60 feet, thence (3) east a distance of 270 feet, thence (4) north a distance of 60 feet to the Point of Beginning.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

1. That the City Council hereby accepts for public right-of-way purposes that real property and/or interest and/or easement described in the Grant Deed dated June 21, 1972, and signed by Edith D. Bubar.

2. That the City Council hereby consents to the recordation of above described Grant Deed.


