

RESOLUTION NO. 451

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST FINDING AND DETERMINING CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER LINES AND APPURTENANT FACILITIES NECESSARY AS HEALTH MEASURE

(Assessment District No. 5)

WHEREAS, certain proceedings have been proposed for construction and installation of sewer lines and related and appurtenant facilities pursuant to the Improvement Act of 1911; and

WHEREAS, said project has been recommended by the Kern County Health Officer as necessary as a health measure;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST HEREBY RESOLVES, ORDERS & DETERMINES:

1. That the letter from Owen A. Kearns, M.D., Health Officer of Kern County, dated January 30, 1973, referred to above, is hereby received and spread upon the minutes of the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest.

2. That the construction and installation of said improvements are hereby found to be necessary as a health measure.
