RESOLUTION NO. 461

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST APPROVING AND ORDERING THE FILING OF ESTIMATE, PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND MAP FOR ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 5

WHEREAS, proceedings have been proposed under the Improvement Act of 1911 for construction of certain improvements, including sanitary sewers and appurtenant facilities; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented an estimate of the cost and expenses of said work, entitled "Engineer's Estimate, Construction of Sewer Work, Assessment District No. 5, Ridgecrest, California"; plans entitled "Plan No. 5, Construction Plans for Sewer Assessment District No. 5, City of Ridgecrest, California", consisting of twelve (12) sheets, numbered 1 through 12 (inclusive); specifications entitled "Specifications of Sewer Work, Assessment District No. 5, Ridgecrest, California", consisting of thirty-four (34) pages, numbered 1 through 34 (inclusive), and a map entitled "City of Ridgecrest, Sewer Assessment District No. 5", consisting of one (1) page, showing the boundaries of the territory to be benefited by said work and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses of said work;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST HEREWITH ORDERS, DETERMINES & RESOLVES:

1. Said estimate, plans and specifications are hereby approved and ordered filed with the City Clerk.

2. Said map of the proposed assessment district is hereby approved, and the City Clerk is directed to endorse his certificate on the original and one (1) copy thereof evidencing the adoption of the resolution of intention, to file the original of said map in the office of the City Clerk, and to file a certified copy of said map with the Kern County Recorder.

3. The provisions for payment of liquidated damages as set forth in said specifications are herewith approved and ordered to be specified in the contract. The amount of said damages and the terms and conditions under which the same shall be payable are hereby fixed as provided in said specifications.
