

RESOLUTION NO. 520

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING IMMEDIATE CERTIFICATION OF POPULATION OF TERRITORY ANNEXED BY ANNEXATION NO. 5. (Desert Park Housing)

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors in its Resolution No. 73-377 adopted May 14, 1973, approved Annexation No. 5, annexing to the City of Ridgecrest portions of the Naval Weapons Center at China Lake, California; and

WHEREAS, The Navy-owned housing in the Desert Park housing area was included in said annexation; and

WHEREAS, Said annexation resolution was filed with the Secretary of State of the State of California on May 24, 1973; and

WHEREAS, This City is informed by the State Controller's office that it normally certifies the population of an "uninhabited" annexation three years after annexation; and

WHEREAS, The annexed Desert Park housing area was and is fully inhabited with military and civilian employees of the Naval Weapons Center and is not scheduled for further housing development;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That the City Council requests the State Controller to immediately certify the population of Desert Park Housing Area annexed by Annexation Proceeding No. 5 on the basis of number of registered voters residing therein (Kern County's China Lake Precinct No. 9).

2. That the City Clerk is instructed to forward copies of this Resolution to the State Controller and the State Department of Finance.




