

RESOLUTION NO. 523

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN LIMITED PARKING ZONES ON BALSAM STREET AND WEST STATION AVENUE

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 87 provides for certain curb markings to designate parking or stopping regulations pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 21458; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of said Ordinance provides that the City Council may cause signs, curb markings, or other devices to be placed so as to regulate vehicular stopping, standing, or parking;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That the following areas are hereby established as restricted standing time zones to be designated by white curb markings and by signs with the following legend, "Stopping for deposit of mail only":

a. On the east side of North Balsam Street from 186 feet to 213 feet north of the northeast corner of Balsam Street and W. French Avenue.

b. On the north side of W. Station Avenue between the end of the curb return on Station Avenue and thirty feet west of the end of the curb return.

2. The above established zones shall not be effective until curb markings and signs are installed in accordance with paragraph 1 of this Resolution.

3. The above established zones shall be subject to the other restrictions applicable in Ordinance No. 87.

4. The Superintendent of Streets is hereby instructed to install the curb markings and signs specified above.
