

RESOLUTION NO. 553

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN LIMITED PARKING ZONES ADJACENT TO THE FRONTS OF STORES IN THE RIDGECREST PLAZA SHOPPING CENTER

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 87 provides for certain curb markings to designate parking or stopping regulations pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 21458; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of said Ordinance provides that the City Council may cause signs, curb markings, or other devices to be placed so as to regulate vehicular stopping, standing, or parking; and

WHEREAS, A majority of the merchants doing business in the Ridgcrest Plaza Shopping Center at the northeast corner of Ridgcrest and China Lake Boulevards have requested that the City Council prohibit parking along the curb in front of said stores; and

WHEREAS, The City Council finds that the prohibition of such parking is required for emergency vehicle access to the stores in said shopping center;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. That the curb between store fronts and the parking lot in front of said stores in the Ridgcrest Plaza Shopping Center is hereby established as no parking zones in accordance with paragraph 1.a. of Ordinance No. 87 and shall be designated as such by marking the curb red.

2. The Superintendent of Streets is hereby instructed to install the curb markings specified above.
