

RESOLUTION NO. 74-2

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING INTENT
TO CONSIDER GRANTING A CABLE TELEVISION
FRANCHISE TO PACIFIC MASTER SYSTEMS, INC.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 185 authorizes the City Council to grant non-exclusive franchises for the operation of cable television systems in the City of Ridgecrest, and

WHEREAS, The City Council has received an application for a franchise from Pacific Master Systems, Inc., of Pacific Palisades, California, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 185 requires the City Council to hold a public hearing on consideration of granting a cable television franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES:

1. That the City Council hereby declares its intent to consider granting of a cable television franchise to Pacific Master Systems, Inc.

2. That the City Council sets 8:00 P.M., January 17, 1974, as the time and date and the City Council Chamber in City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, as the place for the conduct of a public hearing on the question of granting a cable television franchise to Pacific Master Systems, Inc., at which time and place any persons having any interest in the granting of the proposed franchise or any objection to the granting of same may file written protests and appear before the Council and be heard.

3. That the proposed terms and conditions upon which said franchise is to be granted are those contained in Resolution No. 489 adopting rules, regulations, and standards governing operation of cable television system in the City, and the following:

(a) that the proposed rates to be applicable to the operation of Pacific Master Systems, Inc., franchise shall be those contained in the application filed by said firm with the City Clerk.

(b) that the number and names of channels proposed to be provided by Pacific Master Systems, Inc., shall be those specified in said application filed with the City Clerk.

(c) that Pacific Master Systems, Inc., shall first show to the City Council that it has obtained Kern County franchises to operate cable television systems in Boron, North Edwards, Mojave, and Rosamond and that it has obtained a franchise to operate a cable television system in California City.

(d) that Pacific Master Systems, Inc., shall first agree not to propose a rate increase for two years following the date of granting of a franchise to Pacific Master Systems, Inc.

(e) that Pacific Master Systems, Inc., provide a map showing dates of phased construction of the system in the City of Ridgecrest or state that Pacific Master Systems, Inc.'s, system in the City of Ridgecrest will not be connected to a single residential or commercial unit until the system is constructed in the entire City.

4. That the application of Pacific Master Systems, Inc., is available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk, Administrative Department, City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California.
