BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant agrees to provide the required matching funds to said project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement expenditures.

Project Summary The Ridgecrest Police Department intends to equip the patrol officer with versatile radio communications by supplying the officer with a personal portable two-way radio that will enable the officer to carry his communications with him wherever he is required to go on call, giving him instant contact with police headquarters or other units.

The personal radio system will accomplish numerous objectives:

1. Eliminate the restriction to his vehicle.
2. Offer the officer greater protection.
3. Allow more public contact.
4. Place communications directly at trouble scene.
5. Increase available manpower hours lost in delayed calls.
6. Reduce critical response time.

It will be necessary to install a mountain top repeater to supply the low volum personal radios with increased volum, extended range and broader coverage to function properly throughout the city. Once this system is in effect, the citizen and criminal will both be aware of its capabilities. The former for its useful service, the latter for its prevention and apprehension. The program will be evaluated on the basis of delayed response to calls, citizens comments and crime statistics, such as attacks on officers, etc.
