

RESOLUTION NO. 74-65

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING
THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1974-75

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California, has considered the proposed budget for the fiscal year 1974-75; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on said proposed budget and all persons desiring to be heard thereon were given the opportunity to make comments and recommendations and objections; and

WHEREAS, various changes and amendments in said proposed budget have been made, and the City Council desires to adopt in final form the proposed budget as changed and amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
RESOLVES:

1. That the proposed budget for the fiscal year 1974-75 in the amount of \$3,778,229.45, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is herewith approved and adopted.
2. That the City Council hereby authorizes transfer from the Transient Occupancy Tax Fund to the General Fund of \$56,476.48 for expenditure for community promotion and recreation purposes in 1974-75.
3. That the City Council hereby authorizes transfer of \$96,849.13 from the State Gas Tax Fund to the General Fund for expenditure for the construction and maintenance of City streets in 1974-75.
4. That the City Council hereby authorizes transfer of \$62,216.00 from the Local Transportation Fund to the General Fund for expenditure for construction of improvements on City streets.
5. That the City Council authorizes transfer of \$2,411.00 from the Traffic Safety Fund to the General Fund for expenditure for Police Department salary and other costs.
6. That the City Council hereby authorizes transfer of \$12,000 from the Regional Park Development Fund for expenditure for Police Department salary and other costs.
7. That the City Council authorizes transfer of \$53,276.40 from the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund to the General Fund for expenditure for payment on Police facility in County Justice Building and other costs

8. That at least three (3) copies of said 1974-75 budget in its final and approved form, as adopted herein, shall be filed with the City Clerk and shall be open to public inspection at all reasonable times.


