

RESOLUTION NO. 74-66

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL FOR COST REIMBURSEMENT FUNDING FOR ABATEMENT OF ABANDONED VEHICLES

WHEREAS, The City of Ridgecrest since enactment of Ordinance No. 90 in November of 1968 has continuously conducted a program for abatement of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles and parts thereof from private and public properties as authorized by State Vehicle Code Section 22660; and

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of California in Senate Bill 300 (Chapter 49 of the 1973 Legislative Session) transferred to the State Department of the California Highway Patrol the authority to administer the Abandoned Vehicle Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, By entering into contract with the State Department of the California Highway Patrol the City of Ridgecrest can receive reimbursement from the Abandoned Vehicle Trust Fund for its costs of abatement of the above described vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

That the City Administrator is authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Ridgecrest a contract with the State Department of the California Highway Patrol for City participation in the Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Program.
