

RESOLUTION NO. 74-69

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF RIDGECREST AUTHORIZING USE OF CONSENT  
CALENDAR FOR AGENDA OF REGULAR CITY COUNCIL  
MEETINGS

WHEREAS, it is desirable to provide a method for handling routine matters at regular City Council meetings without the necessity for individual review, comment or action; and

WHEREAS, a consent calendar for the agenda of regular City Council meetings can provide such method, thus expediting City Council meetings without depriving any person on the City Council, or any member of the public, of the right to question, comment on, or otherwise request consideration of any individual item on the consent calendar;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREWITH RESOLVED, ORDERED AND DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That use of a consent calendar for the agenda of the regular meetings of the City Council is herewith authorized.

2. That all items for consideration or action by the City Council which do not require individual or extensive consideration, and which can generally be handled by simple approval or common action, shall be included on the City Council agenda under the consent calendar. All such items may be approved or otherwise acted upon by a single action of the City Council, and any such action shall be valid and effective as to each individual item included on the consent calendar.

3. That any Council Member, or any member of the public, may at any time prior to action on the consent calendar request that any particular item thereon be withdrawn and considered and acted on separately and specifically, in which case such procedure shall be followed.


