

RESOLUTION NO. 74-7

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING RECOMMENDATION
OF HEALTH OFFICER, AND FINDING PROCEEDINGS
NECESSARY AS A HEALTH MEASURE

(ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 8)

WHEREAS, proceedings have been recommended for construction of sewer facilities within the area designated as proposed Assessment District No. 8; and

WHEREAS, the Kern County Health Officer has recommended, in writing, that such proceedings be instituted as a necessary health measure;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, HEREWITH RESOLVES, ORDERS AND DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the letter of the Kern County Health Officer, dated September 12, 1973, recommending that proceedings be initiated in proposed Assessment District No. 8 as a health measure, is approved and spread upon the minutes of the City Council.

2. That the necessity for such proceedings as a health measure is hereby approved, adopted, and found to exist, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 2808.


