

RESOLUTION NO. 74-82

CITY OF RIDGECREST

RESOLUTION REFERENCING PREVAILING WAGE SCALE,  
AND DIRECTING CALL FOR CONSTRUCTION BIDS.

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 8B

WHEREAS, proceedings have been heretofore instituted under the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913," being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California for the construction of certain public works of improvement in a special assessment district entitled ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 8B; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of this legislative body to also call for sealed proposals or bids for the doing of said work and improvements in said assessment district; and

WHEREAS, it is also to determine the prevailing rate of wages for the various classifications of workmen required in the performance of said work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are all true and correct.

SECTION 2. It is hereby determined and ascertained that the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which said work described is to be performed in the matter of the construction of certain public improvement work together with appurtenances in ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 8B under the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913," being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and also the general prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work for each craft or type of workman or mechanic, is in accordance with the schedule adopted by Resolution No. 74-59. Said Resolution No. 74-59 adopted on the 1st day of August, 1974, is hereby referenced, incorporated and made a part of these proceedings.

SECTION 3. Attached hereto is the form of Notice Inviting Sealed Proposals or Bids for the construction of the works of improvement in said district and the terms and conditions in said proposals are hereby adopted and approved.

SECTION 4. The proposals or bids shall be delivered to the City Clerk and opened and examined at a public meeting so called; and said results of the bidding shall be reported to the legislative body at the next regular meeting after the opening of the bids.
