RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL ACTING ON
HEALTH OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION ADOPTED
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 2808
OF DIVISION 4 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS
CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 10

WHEREAS, there has been received a written recommendation from the Health Officer of the County acting as the Health Officer of the City for the construction of certain sanitary sewer improvements and necessary appurtenances in what is known as

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 10

WHEREAS, this body has duly considered said letter recommendation of said Health Officer and has received information and testimony with reference to the proposed sewer improvements, particularly referred to in said recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are all true and correct.

SECTION 2. Reference is hereby made to a map previously adopted showing the proposed works of improvement proposed to be constructed within said assessment district.

SECTION 3. The improvements referred to in said Health Officer's recommendation are for the construction of sanitary sewer improvements together with appurtenances and appurtenant work in connection therewith, in an assessment district known as

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 10

SECTION 4. It is hereby declared and determined that the construction of said sanitary sewer improvements including appurtenances and appurtenant work in connection therewith, and each of them, is necessary as a health measure, and the necessity for such construction and improvement is hereby found to exist.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Section 2808 of Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, and the City Council, in adopting this Resolution, intends to meet each and every condition and to make each and every finding necessary on its part in order to permit the proceedings for said improvement to go forward to completion without further reference to, compliance with, or application of, the provisions of said Division 4 of said Streets and Highways Code.

SECTION 6. The opinion of the Health Officer of the County dated the 14th day of DECEMBER, 1976, be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION 7. Said improvement for the construction of sanitary sewer improvements is necessary for the inhabitants of the area and use of the property benefited, and that such project is feasible, and that the lands to be assessed will be able to carry the burden of such proposed assessment.

SECTION 8. The proceedings are to be pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913", being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.



Gentlemen:

As Health Officer of the County of Kern and the Incorporated Cities therein, I hereby recommend that proceedings relative to the installation of sanitary sewers be instituted as soon as possible in the proposed Sewer Assessment District No. 10 as shown on the attached maps.

The designated areas have, for the most part, been subdivided into small lots averaging less than 7,000 square feet. The installation of septic systems, if continued, is likely to cause public health hazards, and would not be in the best interest of the community. At best, the installation of septic systems in this area can only be expected as a temporary means of disposing of sewage, needing constant care in maintenance and operation.


Without public sewers, housing improvement and development in this area would be difficult, if not impossible in some cases. Therefore, this recommendation is made as a measure necessary for the protection of public health and the orderly development of the area in accordance with good public health principles.

The proceedings for the construction of said sewers, including all appurtenances and acquisition, pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913" as proposed, are necessary as a health measure.

This recommendation is made pursuant to the provisions of Section 2808 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California and this

Department is fully prepared to support the necessity of this measure as a protection to the public health.


