RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL REFERENCING  
PREVAILING WAGE SCALE AND DIRECTING CALL FOR  
CONSTRUCTION BIDS.

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 10

WHEREAS, proceedings have been heretofore instituted under the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913", being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California for the construction of certain public works of improvements in a special assessment district known and designated as

ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 10

(hereinafter referred to as the "Assessment District"); and,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of this Legislative Body to also call for sealed proposals or bids for the doing of said work and improvements in said assessment district; and,

WHEREAS, it is also to determine the prevailing rate of wages for the various classifications of workmen required in the performance of said work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE

CITY OF RIDGECREST

AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined and ascertained that the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which said work described is to be performed in the matter of the construction of certain public improvement work, together with appurtenances in the Assessment District under the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913", being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and also the general prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work for each craft or type of workman or mechanic, is in accordance with the schedule adopted by Resolution No. 77-13. Said Resolution adopted on the 2nd day of FEBRUARY, 1977, is hereby referenced, incorporated and made a part of these proceedings.

SECTION 3. That the proposals or bids shall be opened and examined at a public meeting so called; and said results of the bidding shall be reported to the legislative body at the next regular meeting after the opening of the bids.

SECTION 4. That the terms and conditions for bidding on the works of improvements for this Assessment District are hereby approved and adopted by this City Council, attached hereto, referenced and so incorporated and, further, identified as follows:

SECTION 5. That the City Council hereby finds and determines that in the event that the contractor, contracting owners included, does not complete the work within the limit specified in the contract, or within such further time as the legislative body shall authorize, the contractor or contracting owners, as the case may be, shall pay as liquidated damages, the amount of \$ 200.00 per day. That it is impractical to determine the actual damage which the City will sustain by reason of such delay but that the above sum is a reasonable amount for said liquidated damages and is not being imposed as a penalty.

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Clerk on behalf of and as authorized by the City of Ridgecrest, California, will receive sealed bids up to the hour of 4:00 o'clock P.M. on Tuesday, the 15th day of March, 1977. Said bids will thereafter be referred to the City Council for consideration at the next regular meeting.

PROCEEDINGS

The works and improvements hereinafter mentioned are authorized pursuant to the provision of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913", being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, and said project will be financed pursuant to bonds being issued according to the terms and provisions of the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915", being Division 10 of said Code.

WORKS OF IMPROVEMENT

The construction of certain sanitary sewer improvements including service laterals together with appurtenances and appurtenant work in certain public streets and rights-of-way within the city limits of the City of Ridgecrest, California in a special assessment district entitled ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 10: West Bowman Road, West Vulcan Avenue, West Hood Avenue, West Perch Avenue, West Bataan Avenue, West Leyte Avenue, West Coral Avenue, West Wasp Avenue, West Dolphin Avenue, West Sullivan Avenue, West Burns Avenue, West Hughes Avenue, West Franklin Avenue, Oregon Avenue, Idaho Avenue, South China Lake Boulevard, Alley North of South China Lake Boulevard from West Saratoga Avenue to South Downs Street, Alley South of South China Lake Boulevard from West Saratoga Avenue to South Downs Street, South Mahan Street, South Porter Street, South Mayo Street, South Sims Street, South Farragut Street, South McCall Street, South Yorktown Street, South Ranger Street, South Downs Street, South Scott Street, South Allen Street, South Norma Street, Alley North of East Commercial Avenue from 200 ± feet East of South American to 400 ± feet West of South American,

East Commercial Avenue, East Church Avenue, East Upjohn Avenue, South Broadway Street, South Primrose Street, South Orchard Street, South Gateway Boulevard, South Fountain Street, South Valley Street, South Lincoln Street, South Richmond Street, South Lumill Street, Easement Northwest of proposed State Highway 178.

#### PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

All of the above work is to be done under contract in accordance with those certain plans, specifications and drawings contained in a "report" contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 77-11 considered and approved on the 2nd day of February, 1977 and other contract documents, reference is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained from the office of the City Clerk, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California or at the office of the City Engineer, Don G. Simpson, 2200 "F" Street, Bakersfield, California. A non-refundable deposit of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) in the form of a United States Postal Money Order, or a certified or cashier's check, made payable to the City of Ridgecrest, will be required for each set of plans and specifications obtained by a bidder.

#### PROPOSALS

Proposals must be submitted on the blank forms prepared and furnished for the purpose and which may be obtained at the office of the City Engineer.

#### BONDS

The contractor will be required to furnish with the contract a faithful performance bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the aggregate amount of the bid, and a labor and material bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%). The contractor will also furnish certificates of insurance evidencing all insurance coverage as required by the specifications has been so secured.

#### PREVAILING WAGES

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that there has been heretofore established a prevailing rate and scale of wages in accordance with law to be paid in the construction of the above entitled improvements. The said rate and scale was adopted by Resolution No. on the 2nd day of February, 1977 and is on file in the office of the City Clerk. The said rates and scales are herein referred to and adopted in this notice as though fully and completely set forth herein, and that said scale as adopted by said Resolution is made a part of this Notice by reference.

### PAYMENT

Payments will be made in cash to the Contractor in accordance with the provisions of the specifications and on itemized estimates duly certified and approved by the Superintendent of Streets submitted in accordance therewith, based on labor and materials incorporated into said work during the preceding month by the Contractor. The first progress payment will not be made until after delivery of bonds and receipt of monies thereof.

### BID SECURITY

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check, payable to the order of the City of Ridgecrest amounting to ten percent (10%) of the bid, or by a bond in said amount and payable to said City by a corporate surety or sureties authorized to do business in the State of California. Said check shall be forfeited or said bond shall become payable in case the bidder depositing the same does not, within fifteen (15) days after written notice, sign the contract.

### AWARD AND EXECUTION

Any award of contract will be made subject to the receipt of monies and proceeds from issuance and sale of bonds.

The Contractor shall execute the contract within fifteen (15) days after he has been notified in writing that the contract has been awarded to him, and shall commence construction within five (5) days after contract execution and shall complete all the work and improvements within two hundred forty (240) calendar days after execution.

The City Council hereby reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to waive any irregularity, and to award the contract to other than the lowest bidder. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of seventy-five (75) days after the bid opening.
