

RESOLUTION NO. 77-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING
THE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR
PROPOSED ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 10

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest is proposing to establish Assessment District #10 for the purpose of providing sewer service to a portion of the City; and

WHEREAS, one of the requirements to receive Farmers Home Administration financing for the proposed sewer project is for the City Council to review form AD 624(12-72) entitled U. S. Department of Agriculture, Application for Federal Assistance (For Construction Programs).


