A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF RIDGECREST REQUESTING OBLIGATION  
OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of creating an assessment district for the construction of sewers in certain portions of the City of Ridgecrest; and

WHEREAS, the City is unable to finance the proposed Assessment District #10 without a loan; and

WHEREAS, the City is seeking assistance from the Farmers Home Administration in the amount of \$2,456,000 in order to proceed with the project:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


1. That it is desirous that the Farmers Home Administration obligate \$2,456,000 for proposed Assessment District #10.




