

RESOLUTION NO. 77-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING PRIORITY PLAN FOR EXPENDITURE UNDER PROVISIONS OF THE NEJEDLY-HART STATE, URBAN, AND COASTAL PARK BOND ACT OF 1976

WHEREAS, the Nejedly-Hart State, Urban, and Coastal Park Bond Act of 1976 requires that each county shall consult with all cities and districts within the county which are eligible to receive grant funds under provisions of the Act and develop and submit to the State for approval, a priority plan for expenditure of the county's allocation; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kern has consulted with said cities and districts and has prepared a priority plan for expenditure of the County's allocation, including expenditure by eligible cities and districts; and

WHEREAS, said priority plan must be approved by at least fifty (50) percent of the cities and districts representing fifty (50) percent of the population of the cities and districts within the County:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:

1. The the City Council approves the County of Kern Priority Plan for expenditure of allocated funds under the provisions of the Nejedly-Hart State, Urban, and Coastal Park Bond Act of 1976.
