

RESOLUTION NO. 77-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, MAKING
THE APPLICATION FOR TITLE VII GRANT OF
THE SENIOR CITIZEN NUTRITION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has submitted a letter of intent to the California Office on Aging indicating its desire to provide services for senior citizens in the City of Ridgecrest and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, The City Council, at a regular meeting held April 20, 1977, considered submitting the application for a nutrition program to provide services to the senior citizens of our area; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department on Aging require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications prior to submission of said applications:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, HEREBY:

1. Approves the filing of an application for Title VII Grant of the Senior Citizen Nutrition Program.
2. Certifies that said agency understands the assurances in the application.
3. Appoints the City Administrator as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit with the Mayor's signature and City Council approval, all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, etc., which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned grant.


