

RESOLUTION NO. 77-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR THE LEASE AND PURCHASE OF NATIONAL RESOURCE LANDS FOR USE AS AN OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE PARK

WHEREAS, the people of the United States of America have enacted the Recreation and Public Purposes Act of 1954, with subsequent amendments, which provides for the lease and sale of National Resource Lands for approved recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Department of the Interior, through the Bureau of Land Management, is authorized to accept applications and administer said lease and sale of said lands, and has set up procedures governing applications by local agencies; and

WHEREAS, said applications and procedures specify requirements, commitments, terms and conditions that the applicant must comply with:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA RESOLVES:

1. That the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest understands the requirements, commitments, terms and conditions of said application.
2. That the City of Ridgecrest intends and is hereby authorized to apply for the lease and subsequent sale of certain specified National Resource Lands for the purposes of development and operation of an off-highway vehicle park.
3. That the Mayor of the City of Ridgecrest is hereby authorized to sign said application.
