

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF RIDGECREST DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER  
VACATION OF PART OF PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT  
IN TRACT 1771, LOTS 56 AND 57.

WHEREAS, it appears that the portion of the public utility easement described hereinbelow is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a public hearing thereon pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Public Service Easements Vacation Law (Calif. Gov't Code Secs. 50430 ff.);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREWITH RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council declares its intention to vacate part of the public utilities easement described hereinafter.

2. The part of said easement proposed to be vacated is shown on the map or plan on file in the office of the City Clerk, and is described as follows:

That portion of the public utilities easements in Tract 1771, in the City Ridgecrest, County of Kern, State of California, as recorded in Book 9, Page 74, on June 22, 1956, Kern County Recorder's Office, and more particularly described as follows:

A six (6) foot public utility easement on the east side of lot 56 along the course N 5°80'40" for a distance of 114.41 ft, and a six (6) foot public utility easement in the northern portion of lot 57 along the course N 25°51'16" for a distance of 105.659 ft, Tract 1771.

3. A hearing on this matter is set for 7:00, on October 5 1977, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed public utility easement vacation, may appear and be heard.

4. This resolution, or notice thereof, shall be published and posted in the manner required by law.


