RESOLUTION NO. 77-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST ORDERING THE VACATION OF PART OF PUBLIC
UTILITY EASEMENTS IN TRACT 1771.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest has previously adopted a resolution declaring its intention to vacate that portion of the public utility easement described hereinafter; and

NO FEE

WHEREAS, notice of said proposed action was published and posted in the manner required by law, and a hearing was held for the purpose of hearing evidence by all interested persons; and

WHEREAS, no objections to said proposed vacation were made or entered;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST HEREWITH RESOLVES, ORDERS AND DETERMINES:

1. That from all the evidence submitted, the following portions of the public utility easement described hereinafter are unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and they are hereby ordered vacated:

That portion of the public utilities easements in Tract 1771, in the City of Ridgecrest, County of Kern, State of California, as recorded in Book 9, Page 74, on June 22, 1956, Kern County Recorder's Office, and more particularly described as follows:

A six (6) foot public utility easement on the east side of Lot 56 along the course N 5°08'40" for a distance of 114.41 feet, and a six (6) foot public utility easement in the northern portion of Lot 57 along the course N 25°51'16" for a distance of 105.659 feet, Tract 1771.

2. That a certified copy of this resolution shall immediately hereafter be recorded by the City Clerk in the Kern County Recorder's office.
