

RESOLUTION NO. 79-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, PROHIBITING SMOKING IN THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBER WHILE A PUBLIC MEETING IS IN PROCESS

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the California Indoor Clean Air Act of 1976, certain areas of publicly owned buildings must be designated to prohibit the smoking of tobacco; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to so designate these areas in the Council Chamber area of City Hall:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:


1. Smoking shall be prohibited in the City Council Chamber (carpeted area) while a public meeting is in process.
2. Staff is instructed to post the required signs which prohibit smoking in this area.
