

RESOLUTION NO. 79-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING
RESOLUTION NO. 123, TO PROVIDE FOR
COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES TEMPORARILY
ASSIGNED TO A HIGHER CLASSIFICATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 123 and subsequent amendments do not address the situation of employees having to work temporarily in a higher classification; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to revise the Personnel System Rules and Regulations to provide for this type of situation in an equitable manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Rule IX of the Personnel System Rules and Regulations is hereby amended to add:

"SECTION 6. Temporary Appointment. An employee who has been temporarily assigned to a position in a higher classification for a period in excess of thirty (30) consecutive days shall be compensated, beginning the 31st day, at the salary schedule for that position in a step which would afford the employee at least a 5% salary increase in recognition of extra duties performed."

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall apply to all temporary appointments made on or after the date of adoption of this resolution, provided, however, that for appointments made prior to the date of adoption of this resolution, the 30-day period shall be deemed to be satisfied.
