RESOLUTION NO. 79-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST ORDERING THE VACATION OF PART OF A
PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT IN TRACT 1619, LOT 155

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest had previously adopted a resolution declaring its intention to vacate that portion of the public utility easement described hereinafter; and

WHEREAS, notice of said proposed action was published and posted in the manner required by law, and a hearing was held for the purpose of hearing evidence by all interested persons; and

WHEREAS, no objections to said proposed vacation were made or entered;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST HEREWITH RESOLVES, ORDERS AND DETERMINES:

1. That from all the evidence submitted, the following portions of the public utility easement described hereinafter are unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and they are hereby ordered vacated:

That portion of the public utilities easement in Tract 1619, in the City of Ridgecrest, County of Kern, State of California, as recorded in Book 7, Page 200, on April 1, 1952, Kern County Recorder's Office, and more particularly described as follows:

The easterly 20 feet along the course of N 0°24'16"E for a distance of 53.00' along the eastern portion of Lot 155, Tract 1619.

That all obstructions and utilities, if required, be removed or relocated at the expense of the property owner.

2. That a certified copy of resolution shall immediately hereafter be recorded by the City Clerk in the Kern County Recorder's Office.
