

RESOLUTION NO. 79-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, URGING THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO RETAIN THE BOWMAN ROAD (FUTURE ROUTE 178) RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND NOT RECYCLE THE ROUTE AS RECOMMENDED BY CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) has prepared a study of the existing Highway 178 and future Highway 178; and

WHEREAS, CALTRANS has made a recommendation to the California Transportation Commission to recycle the future Highway 178 (Bowman Road); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest adopted a resolution in 1965 requesting that Bowman Road be constructed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest General Plan shows the future Route No. 178 as a major transportation corridor; and

WHEREAS, there is strong support for the CALTRANS to retain the right-of-way for future Route 178.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest urges the California Transportation Commission retain the right-of-way for future Route No. 178 (Bowman Road).
