

RESOLUTION NO. 79-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER VACATION OF PART OF PUBLIC UTILITY AND FUTURE ALLEY EASEMENT IN TRACT 1619, LOTS 150-172.

WHEREAS, it appears that the portion of the public utility easement and future alley described hereinbelow is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a public hearing thereon pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Public Service Easements Vacation Law (Calif. Gov't Code Secs. 50430 ff.);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREWITH RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council declares its intention to vacate part of the public utilities easement and future alley described hereinafter.
2. The part of said easement and future alley proposed to be vacated is shown on the map or plan on file in the office of the City Clerk, and is described as follows:

That portion of the public utilities easement and future alley in Tract 1619, in the City of Ridgecrest, County of Kern, State of California, as recorded in Book 7, Page 200, on April, 1952, Kern County Recorder's Office, and more particularly described as follows:

The east 20 feet of Lots 150 through 172, of Tract 1619.

3. A hearing on this matter is set for 7:00 p.m., on December 19th, 1979, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed public utility easement vacation, may appear and be heard.

4. This resolution, or notice thereof, shall be published and posted in the manner required by law.
