

RESOLUTION NO. 79-6

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST PROVIDING FOR PARTIAL CITY PICK UP OF THE EMPLOYEES CONTRIBUTION FOR SOCIAL SECURITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest is desirous of improving upon the fringe benefits provided to City employees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council had previously considered and agreed to pick up 3½ percent of the employee's retirement system contribution; and

WHEREAS, it now seems more desirable for both the City and the employee to pick up 3½ percent of the employee's social security contribution rather than the retirement system contribution; and

WHEREAS, it is also desirable to pick up the full 6.13 percent of the employee's social security contribution for the remainder of this fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds have been approved and included in the current fiscal year budget for the purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES HEREBY AMEND THE BENEFITS PROVIDED TO EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City will pay 3½ percent toward the employee's share of Social Security.

Section 2: The City will pay the full 6.13 percent toward the employee's share of Social Security through the end of the current fiscal year (June 30, 1979).

Section 3: The payment of benefits in Section 2 shall begin with the current pay period, and the payment of benefits in Section 1 shall become effective July 1, 1979.
