

RESOLUTION NO. 80-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS GRANDE WAY, GEORGE HUCEK, APPLICANT; JOHN COX, CONSULTING ENGINEER

WHEREAS, it appears that the portion of Grande Way located between Lot No. 1 and No. 60 of Tract Map 1525 is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a public hearing thereon pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Public Service Easements Vacation Law (Calif. Gov't. Code Secs. 50430 ff.);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREWITH RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council declares its intention to vacate part of the public utilities easement described hereinafter.

2. The part of said easement proposed to be vacated is shown on the map or plan on file in the office of the City Clerk, and is described as follows:

In Tract 1524, in the City of Ridgecrest, County of Kern, State of California, as recorded in Book 7 of Maps, on February 20, 1950, in the office of the Kern County Recorder's Office and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Grande Way (formerly called Sierra Grande Blvd.) as recorded in said Tract, said Grande Way lies between Lots 1 and 60 of said Tract and is 50 feet wide and runs north and south, the westerly 40 feet to be reserved for utility easements.

3. A hearing on this matter is set for 7:00 P.M., on March 19, 1980, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed public utility easement vacation, may appear and be heard.

4. This resolution, or notice thereof, shall be published and posted in the manner required by law.


