

RESOLUTION NO. 80-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE CONCEPT OF
A PROPOSAL FOR A PROGRAM OF CAREER CRIMINAL
APPREHENSION AND PROSECUTION

WHEREAS, the Kern County Criminal Justice Planning Committee is responsible for recommending the allocation of federal funds for criminal justice improvement programs, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the federal funds is to strengthen and improve the criminal and juvenile justice systems, and

WHEREAS, the Committee has established three funding priorities for new programs, one of which is career criminal apprehension and prosecution, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has defined needs in this area and has developed a proposed program to implement this approach,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California:

1. Supports the concept of a program for the apprehension and prosecution of career criminals.
2. Authorizes staff to submit a project application for this program to the Kern County Criminal Justice Planning Committee.


