

RESOLUTION NO. 80-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO PROPOSITION 9, WHICH WILL FURTHER ERODE LOCAL CONTROL OF PUBLIC SERVICES, AND URGING A "NO" VOTE

WHEREAS, the ballot for the upcoming primary election on June 3, 1980 contains a proposition aimed at cutting state income taxes, Proposition 9; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 9, also called Jarvis II, seeks to reduce the State Income Tax by "at least" 50%; and

WHEREAS, if Proposition 9 passes, there are indications that the State Legislature will make up the lost revenues from traditional sources of local government funding; and

WHEREAS, local government services, including cities, counties and schools will be affected by this proposition, not the State; and

WHEREAS, actions of this type will further erode local control of public services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST that it expresses its opposition to Proposition 9 on the June 3, 1980 Ballot and urges a "NO" vote on this measure.
