

RESOLUTION NO. 80-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING DEPARTMENTAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODES WHICH INCORPORATE BY REFERENCE THE FAIR POLITICAL PRACTICES COMMISSION'S STANDARD CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 81000, et seq., requires every state or local government agency to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Adm. Code Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard model Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which will be amended to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearings conducted by the Fair Political Practices Commission pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, Government Code Sections 11370, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, this body has determined that the attached Appendices accurately set forth those positions which should be designated and the categories of financial interests which should be made reportable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The terms of 2 Cal. Adm. Code Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission along with the attached Appendices in which officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, are hereby incorporated by reference and constitute the Conflict of Interest Codes of the following departments:
 - A. Administrative Department
 - B. Clerk's Department
 - C. Finance Department
 - D. Legal Department
 - E. Planning Department
 - F. Police Department
 - G. Parks and Recreation Department
 - H. Public Works Department
2. Persons holding designated positions shall file statements of economic interests pursuant to Section 4 (C) of the Conflict of Interest Code.

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3. Pursuant to Section 4 (C) of the Code, all designated employees shall file their Statements with the City Clerk to whom the City Council hereby delegates the authority to carry out the duties of filing officer.





APPENDIX B

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

General Provisions

When a designated employee is required to disclose investments and sources of income, he need only disclose investments in business entities and sources of income which do business in the jurisdiction, plan to do business in the jurisdiction or have done business in the jurisdiction within the past two years. In addition to other activities, a business entity is doing business within the jurisdiction if it owns real property within the jurisdiction. When a designated employee is required to disclose interests in real property, he need only disclose real property which is located in whole or in part within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the jurisdiction or within two miles of any land owned or used by the local government agency.

Designated employees shall disclose their financial interests pursuant to the appropriate disclosure category as indicated in Appendix A. Mutual funds need not be listed.

Disclosure Categories

Category 1: All investments and sources of income totalling \$250.00 or more from any one source. Also, any loans of \$10,000.00 or more, excluding the mortgage on the employee's personal residence.

Category 2: All interests in real property, excluding the employees personal residence.

Category 3: All investments, interests in real property and sources of income subject to the regulatory, permit or licensing authority of the department.

Category 4: Investments in business entities and sources of income which engage in land development, construction or the acquisition or sale of real property.

Category 5: Interests in real property located within two miles of any land owned or used by the City.

Category 6: Investments in business entities and sources of income of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with the City to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment.

Category 7: Investments in business entities and sources of income of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with the designated employee's department to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment.
