

RESOLUTION NO. 80-40

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF RIDGECREST TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT CHINA LAKE
BOULEVARD AND RIDGECREST BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, there is an undesirable traffic condition at the
intersection of China Lake Boulevard and Ridgecrest Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans and the City of Ridgecrest feel that traffic
conditions can be improved with the construction of a traffic signal;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
RESOLVES:

That the City intends to participate with Cal-Trans in the
construction of a traffic signal, and that the City's portion of the
construction costs will be limited to 50 percent of the signal
construction plus 100 percent of minor work necessary on the City
streets:
