A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH CHINA LAKE BOULEVARD FROM THE SOUTH PROPERTY LINE OF BURGER KING TO FRENCH AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City has received requests to restrict parking in front of Burger King to provide a better sight distance and improved traffic safety conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has discussed this proposal with businesses on the west side of China Lake Boulevard between Ridgecrest Boulevard and French Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the owners of Burger King and Bill Cook's Arco do not oppose the parking restriction; and

WHEREAS, the Streets Committee, Police Department, and Public Works Department have reviewed this request and recommend approval:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES:


That parking will be prohibited on the west side of North China Lake Boulevard from the south property line of Burger King to French Avenue:

APPROVAL OF TRAFFIC REGULATION

A Resolution of the City of Ridgecrest, Numbered 80-43, passed and adopted by the City Council of said City on August 14, 1980, provides for the establishing of a NO PARKING zone commencing at a point 380 feet northerly from the northwest corner of the intersection of China Lake Boulevard and Ridgecrest Boulevard and continuing in a northerly direction along the west side of N. China Lake Boulevard to the intersection of French Avenue. This Resolution has been submitted to the Department of Transportation for approval in accordance with Section 22506 of the California Vehicle Code.

N. China Lake Boulevard is State Highway Route 178, as defined by law.

Resolution No. 80-43, insofar as it relates to State Highway Route 178, is approved subject to the following condition:

The Resolution shall cease to be operative six months after receipt by the City Council of written notice of withdrawal of approval of the Department of Transportation.

This approval is made pursuant to the current delegations of authority from the Director of the Department of Transportation through the Chief Engineer to the District Director.
