

RESOLUTION NO. 80- 47

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGE-  
CREST, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER THE  
VACATION OF A PORTION OF GATEWAY BOULEVARD; ALFRED E.  
KINSTLE, APPLICANT

WHEREAS, it appears that the portion of Gateway Boulevard between Church Avenue and Ridgecrest Boulevard, more particularly described below, is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a public hearing thereon pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Public Service Easements Vacation Law (Calif. Gov't. Code Secs. 50430 ff.);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREWITH RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council declares its intention to vacate part of the public utilities easement described hereinafter.

2. The part of said easement proposed to be vacated is shown on the map or plan on file in the office of the City Clerk, and is described as follows:

All that portion of land in the northwest 1/4 of the northwest 1/4 of Section 2, T.27S., R.40E., M.D.M., in the City of Ridgecrest, State of California, as shown on Tract No. 1619 as recorded in Book 7 of Maps, page 200 in the County Recorder of the County of Kern, described as follows:

The west 10.00 feet of Lots 173, 236, 280 through 293, and 219 through 234.

3. A hearing on this matter is set for 7:00 p.m. on October 1, 1980, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed public right-of-way easement vacation, may appear and be heard.

4. This resolution, or notice thereof, shall be published and posted in the manner required by law.


