

RESOLUTION NO. 80-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF
MEASURE "A" ON THE NOVEMBER 4, 1980 BALLOT

WHEREAS, the November 4, 1980 General Election Ballot in Kern County contains a proposition entitled Measure "A" for consideration by the voters, and

WHEREAS, the passage of Measure "A" on the November 4th ballot would mean that the housing agencies of the cities and county can make application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Farmers Home Administration and the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development for much-needed rental housing construction financing for low, moderate and elderly income residents, and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of expanding this opportunity for the citizens of Ridgecrest and of Kern County, and

WHEREAS, the Measure affords a means of local control in the location and number of units to be constructed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California, that it hereby goes "on record" as supporting the passage of Measure "A" on the November 4, 1980 General Election Ballot.
