

RESOLUTION NO. 81-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER VACATION OF TEN (10) FEET OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN TRACT 1382, LOT 19, FOURSQUARE GOSPEL CHURCH, APPLICANT.

WHEREAS, it appears that the portion of the right-of-way described hereinbelow is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a public hearing thereon pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Public Service Easements Vacation Law (Calif. Gov't Code Secs. 50430 ff.)

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREWITH RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council declares its intention to vacate part of the right-of-way easement described hereinafter.

2. The part of said right-of-way proposed to be vacated is shown on the map or plan on file in the office of the City Clerk, and is described as follows:

The south ten feet of property of Lot 19, Tract No. 1382, except that the westerly five feet be retained as an easement, located at the corner of South Norma Street and West Church Avenue.

3. A hearing on this matter is set for 7:00pm, on June 17, 1981, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed public utility easement vacation, may appear and be heard.

4. This resolution, or notice thereof, shall be published and posted in the manner required by law.
