

RESOLUTION NO. 81-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER VACATION OF PART OF PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY ON THE NORTH SEVEN (7) FEET OF GRAAF AVENUE, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE TWO (2) ALLEYS, BETWEEN DOWNS STREET AND INYO STREET, ROBERT SERVAIS, APPLICANT.

WHEREAS, it appears that the portion of the public right-of-way described hereinbelow is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to hold a public hearing thereon pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Public Service Easements Vacation Law (Calif. Gov't Code Secs. 50430 ff.);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREWITH RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council declares its intention to vacate part of the public right-of-way described hereinafter.
2. The part of said right-of-way proposed to be vacated is shown on the map or plan on file in the office of the City Clerk, and is described as follows:

The north seven feet of Graaf Avenue, the right-of-way between Inyo Street and Downs Street, excluding the 20-foot alleys and the curb returns at Inyo Street and Downs Street.

3. A hearing on this matter is set for 7:00 p.m., on July 1, 1981, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 139 Balsam Street, Ridgecrest, California, at which time all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed public right-of-way vacation, may appear and be heard.
4. This resolution, or notice thereof, shall be published and posted in the manner required by law.


