

RESOLUTION NO. 81-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE AGREEMENTS WITH COUNTY OF KERN FOR OLDER AMERICANS ACT, TITLE III - C(1) AND C(2) FUNDS, OLDER AMERICANS ACT, REAWARDED TITLE III - C(1) AND C(2) FUNDS, USDA CASH-IN-LIEU OF COMMODITIES FUNDS AND STATE MATCH EQUIVALENT FUNDS FOR THE RIDGECREST NUTRITION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the County of Kern, by letter dated June 4, 1981, notified the City of Ridgecrest that contracts for the Ridgecrest Nutrition Program are to be continued; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out the purposes of Title 45 Code of Federal Regulations, Public Welfare, Chapter XIII Administration on Aging, Part 1321 pursuant to provisions of Title III (Nutrition Program for the Elderly) of the Older American Act of 1965, as amended, the County of Kern has been authorized to receive funds for paying part of the costs for providing older Americans, particularly those with low incomes, with low cost, nutritionally sound meals in strategically located centers where they can obtain other social and rehabilitative services; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out the purposes of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended by Public Law 95-65, the County of Kern has been authorized to receive funds from the Department of Agriculture for paying part of the costs of purchasing food commodities for Title III - C(1) AND C(2), Nutrition Program for the Elderly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST THAT:

1. It accepts the terms and provisions of the County of Kern in conjunction with Ridgecrest Nutrition Program No. 70678101 in an amount not to exceed \$112,271, consisting of \$99,224 for Part C(1) Congregate Nutrition Service and \$13,047 for Part C(2) Home Delivered Nutrition Services, derived from USDA Funds, State Match Equivalent Funds, and Older Americans Act Fund.
2. The term of this agreement is from July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982.
