

RESOLUTION NO. 81- 4

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGE-  
CREST, CALIFORNIA, ENCOURAGING THE LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA  
CITIES TO INCLUDE SMALL CITIES IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF  
THE PROGRAM FOR THE ANNUAL LEAGUE CONFERENCE

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has been a member of the League of California Cities since this City's incorporation in 1963; and

WHEREAS, the majority of cities in California are under 20,000 in population; and

WHEREAS, it has been the experience of members of this Council and City staff that most of the programs presented at League Conferences are directed towards cities of 20,000 and larger populations; and

WHEREAS, the Annual League Conference represents a unique training experience for members of the City Council and staff and involves a substantial commitment in terms of time and funds from limited resources; and

WHEREAS, one of the primary purposes of the League of California Cities should be to assist small cities who have limited staffs and resources, in a cooperative effort, in areas where they are not able to develop this expertise on their own; and

WHEREAS, consideration should be given to forming a Committee of Mayors and Councilmen from cities under 20,000 population to formulate recommendations to the League for programs at the Annual Conference that are of specific benefit to small cities. Furthermore, special consideration should be given to the needs of non-urban cities because of their unique problems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California, that the League of California Cities should be encouraged to make a special effort to include small cities and non-urban cities in the development of programs for the Annual Conference and to insure that programs are developed for small cities.
