

RESOLUTION NO. 81-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DETERMINING DISABILITY OF CERTAIN SAFETY MEMBER FOR PURPOSES OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT LAW

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest, hereinafter referred to as Agency, is a contracting agency of the Public Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the Public Employees' Retirement Law requires that a contracting agency determine whether an employee of such agency in employment in which he is classified as a local safety member is disabled for purposes of the Public Employees' Retirement Law and whether such disability is "industrial" within the meaning of such Law; and

WHEREAS, an application for disability retirement of Kenneth C. Vineyard, employed by the Agency in the position of Police Sergeant, has been filed with the Public Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the medical and other evidence relevant to such alleged disability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the City Council find and determine and it does hereby find and determine that Kenneth C. Vineyard is incapacitated within the meaning of the Public Employees' Retirement Law for performance of his duties in the position of Police Sergeant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE City Council find and determine and it does hereby find and determine that such disability is a result of injury or disease arising out of and in the course of employment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the member was or will be separated from his employment in the position of Police Sergeant, effective August 6, 1981.


