

RESOLUTION NO. 81-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, URGING THE KERN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO RETAIN TWO SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS IN THE EAST KERN COUNTY AREA

WHEREAS, the Kern County Board of Supervisors is obligated under State Law to redraw the supervisorial boundaries after each federal census; and

WHEREAS, the East Kern County desert area has historically been a part of two supervisorial districts; and

WHEREAS, this provides the residents of East Kern County with a more equitable voice in the government of Kern County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, to respectfully urge the Kern County Board of Supervisors to retain the concept of two supervisorial districts representing the East Kern County area.
