

RESOLUTION NO. 81- 5

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, ENDORSING AND SUPPORTING THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE CALIFORNIA RESOURCE RALLY TO BE HELD APRIL 20-26, 1981

WHEREAS, more than 46 million tons of nonhazardous solid wastes are generated each year in California while many of the State's 600 sanitary landfills are closing for want of space or failure to meet health and safety standards; and

WHEREAS, Californians spend more than \$600 million each year to collect, transfer, haul and bury solid wastes that contain hundreds of millions of dollars of valuable energy and materials that could be reused, recycled or otherwise recovered; and

WHEREAS, the State Solid Waste Management Board is the agency responsible for initiating and encouraging statewide and community programs in solid waste management planning and enforcement, recycling, resource reuse, energy recovery, litter control and public education and participation; and

WHEREAS, the State Solid Waste Management Board, with the support of dozens of California public interest groups, businesses, and local governments is sponsoring the Great California Resource Rally to be held April 20 through April 26, 1981, to raise each Californian's awareness of the State's impending garbage crisis and encourage citizen participation in litter control, recycling, and waste reduction activities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council hereby endorses and supports the objectives and goals of the California Resource Rally, and urges all citizens and city personnel and agencies to participate in and support recycling, litter control and waste reduction activities throughout the year, especially during the Rally Week of April 20-26, 1981.
