

RESOLUTION NO. 81- 50

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF RIDGECREST URGING THE KERN COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO PASS A RESOLUTION
IN SUPPORT OF SB215

WHEREAS, SB215 (Foran) has been passed by both Chambers
of the State Legislature and signed by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, SB215 requires for its implementation that County
Boards of Supervisors representing two-thirds of the State's
population must pass, within sixty (60) days from September 17,
1981, resolutions calling for the two-cent gas tax increase; and

WHEREAS, SB215, if implemented, will provide substantial
and greatly needed additional financing for streets and roads;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest,
California, resolves:

1) That the Kern County Board of Supervisors is hereby
urged to pass a resolution calling for implementation of SB215
and forward that resolution to the Governor's Office; and

2) That the City Council extends its appreciation to State
Senator Walter W. Stiern for his support of SB215; and

3) That a certified copy of this resolution be sent by the
City Clerk to the Kern County Board of Supervisors and to Senator
Walter W. Stiern.
