

RESOLUTION NO. 81-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST ADJUSTING TRANSIT FARES FOR THE GREATER RIDGECREST AREA AND OUTLYING TOWNS

WHEREAS, the State Transportation Development Act and the Kern County Council of Governments regulations require that a minimum of 10% of the cost of transit service, exclusive of depreciation, be recovered by fare box revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Area Transit System has for the Greater Ridgecrest Area been recovering from fare box revenue an average of only about 6.1% to 7.7% of that cost after initial startup, in spite of good volume of business; and

WHEREAS, the service to outlying towns has also not met the required recovery ratio;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST does resolve:

That transit fares for the Ridgecrest Area Transit System are amended as follows, effective January 2, 1982:
