

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST CERTIFYING THE FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR CHANGE OF ZONE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES NO. 76-10, A PROPOSAL TO REZONE AN APPROXIMATELY 140-ACRE PARCEL FROM SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R-1-10) AND URBAN RESERVE (UR) TO SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R-1-6), MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (RM-1) AND COMMERCIAL (CG) ZONES.

WHEREAS, Section 21082 of the Environmental Quality Act of 1970 requires that the City must certify Environmental Impact reports consistent with such act and guidelines adopted by the Secretary of the Resources Agency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has adopted objectives, criteria and procedures for preparation and adoption of Environmental Impact Reports as required by Section 21082 of the Environmental Quality Act of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the final Environmental Impact Report for the proposed Change of Zone District Boundaries was prepared pursuant to the provisions of the Environmental Quality Act of 1970:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That the Final Environmental Impact Report for the proposed Change of Zone District Boundaries has been completed in compliance with CEQA and the State Environmental guidelines.
- (2) That the City Council will consider the contents thereof when making its decision on the project.
