

RESOLUTION NO. 82- 4

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OF ITS MEMBERS TO FILE A WRITTEN ARGUMENT REGARDING A CITY MEASURE.

WHEREAS, a regular general municipal election is to be held in the City of Ridgecrest, California, on April 13, 1982, at which there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said City the following measure:

"Shall the Ordinance establishing service fees and penalties to be used solely for wastewater collection and treatment be adopted?"

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That this City Council, being the legislative body of the City of Ridgecrest hereby authorizes

members of said body, to file a written argument in favor of the City measure set forth in the recitals hereof in accordance with Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 5 of the Elections Code of the State of California and to change said argument until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk after which no arguments for or against said City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk.


