

RESOLUTION NO. 83-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING LOCATION OF  
LOADING ZONE

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 82-6, adopted by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest on March 17, 1982, replaced Sections 8-5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Ridgecrest, which set forth designated location of commercial loading zones, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 82-6, further established Sections 8-1.3 and 8-1.4 of the Municipal Code of the City of Ridgecrest which provides that the Council shall, by resolution, determine the location and size of loading zones for materials and passengers.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

1. COMMERCIAL LOADING ZONE BEHIND THE SENIOR CITIZENS BUILDING

Vehicle parking or standing shall be prohibited between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, for any purpose, other than commercial trucks loading or unloading, on the following portion of the Senior Citizens Community Center parking lot.

2. Entire paved area immediately west of the Senior Citizens Building.


